PROMOTER'S CONDITIONS

RULES OF ENTRY

- 1 All competitors must be members of Wandsworth Swimming Club, BJSC Tooting or Leander SC.
- 2 The meet shall be run under ASA Laws and FINA Technical Rules of Swimming.
- 3 In accordance with ASA Child Protection policy, all photographic equipment including mobile phones with cameras must be registered at each gala.
- 4 The minimum age for each event in the Championships will be as follows:
 - 25m and 50m: no minimum age
 - 200m and 100 IM: 9 and over
 - 100m, 400m Free, 800m Free, 1500m Free and 400m IM: 10 and overAge is as at **31 December 2011**.
- 5 There shall be separate events for males and females although they will be swum combined.
- 6 Entry times will be short course times for the event distance.
- 7 The Registration System:
 - Swimmers shall be placed in graduated time order, slowest to fastest. All heats will be spearheaded.
 - Swimmers must check in **during** the published registration period by signing the check in sheet for each event in which they are swimming. A swimmer who is late to register may be placed in an unoccupied lane at the discretion of the meet administrator. If you are delayed in traffic, you should call Alan on 07802 918568 during the registration period.
 - A list of heat and lane assignments will be posted. It is the swimmers responsibility to check the heat sheet and be at the whipping area on time.
 - Five minutes prior to the start of the gala or one event prior to the one in which you are competing, you should present yourself to the Clerk of the Course.
- 8 A medal will be presented to competitors finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any event. The colour of the medal will be determined by their highest position gained in any event. Any competitor gaining a 1st place will receive a Gold medal; a 2nd place will receive a Silver medal and a 3rd place a Bronze medal.
- 9 Trophies shall be presented in each age group.
 - **Age Group awards** will be made to the top male and female swimmer in each age group 7 & Under, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17+.
 - In order to determine the **Age Group Winners** in each **BAGCAT age group**, the Club will use BAG (British Age Group) points for Girls and Boys 9 to 14 & Under. These **Age Group** winners will be determined by taking the aggregate of the highest score in each BAG Category relevant for their age group.
 - In order to determine the **Age Group Winners** in each of the **Girls and Boys 15 & Over age groups**, the Club will use FINA Points. These **Age Group** winners will be determined by taking the aggregate of the FINA Points scored in their best 3 events.
 - The **200m winner** in each age group **9 and over** will be determined by taking the aggregate of the points scored in all the 200m events, including the Individual Medley.
 - **The winners of the 7 & Under and 8 year Age Groups** will be determined by taking the sum of the point score from their best 3 events. Points will be awarded on the basis of 6 for 1st, 5 for 2nd, 4 for 3rd, 3 for 4th, 2 for 5th and 1 for 6th. No points will be awarded for a disqualification.
- 10 If any of the above rules are subsequently found to have been contravened the Promoter shall decide what action if any shall be taken against those concerned.
